**Student Survey Data:**

82% surveyed said they attend the program every day it's open or almost every day it's open.  
100% responded that staff and program leaders really cared about them.  
91% responded that staff and program leaders listen to what they say.  
100% responded that staff and program leaders challenge them to do their best.  
91% responded that staff and program leaders made them feel they can make a difference.  
91% responded that they learn interesting things during the after school program.  
91% responded that the after school program has helped them make and keep friends.  
77% responded that the after school program has helped them learn how to be a leader.  
86% responded that the after school program has helped them get better grades in school.  
82% responded that the after school program has helped them stay out of trouble.  
91% responded that the after school program has helped students get a better sense of what they can do.  
86% responded that the after school program helped them be more creative.  
96% responded that the after school program helped them to stay away from drugs.  
91% responded that the after school program helped them be more active.  
91% responded that the after school program helped them learn about what they can do in the future (college and/or career options).

**Grades:**

45% increased their Math grade by half a grade or more. 50% maintained.  
4% increased their reading/English/Language Arts Grades by half a grade or more. 62% maintained.
