2. 21st CCLC Program Updates from Site Coordinators-Council reviewed the following:
 - a. Grades- 1st nine week grades were reviewed for each site and each site compared and discussed outcomes.
 - b. Attendance-Each site had served approx. 60-65 days thus far. Attendance high in each site.
 - c. Good News-
 - i. Project Pass and Ozone Archery Team had four students who shot a perfect 50 at the 1st Annual Hopkins Co. Tournament.
 - ii. Project Pass has opened a Pottery Class and Creative Carpentry, both are drawing high school students in and students are taking pride in their projects.
 - iii. Ozone is incorporating the MyOn Reading Program into their after-school programming and see success linked with the program. Ozone Coordinator, Melinda Jones, will provide training on January 7th, 2016 at LCMS @ 10:30AM, for all other site coordinators in our county to incorporate the program into their sites.
 - iv. MRA's Coding Club is a huge and growing success. Students do not want to leave when parents show up to get them and are learning to program design. Grades are up the first nine weeks and site coordinator feels it is due to tracking skills students are struggling in through various programs; such as; Lexia, One-on-one Math & Reading tutoring during MRA, MAP assessments and a variety of staff linked to the school day.
 - v. NSA has been included with Jason Lindsey, The Science Guy, as a part of the Ronald McDonald House Charities in a Science Grant. He will provide services about twice a month through the remainder of the school year. NSA will be working with Dominique Wood to incorporate the TechWizards program into the NSA and MRA program.
