- A. November's Agenda and August's Minutes were read and no corrections were suggested.
- B. Calendar Information:
  - An updated calendar was given to all attendees. Adjustments will be made as the year progresses. A minimum of 90 days must be offered for afterschool programming during the regular school year.
- C. Site Activities Update:
  - OZONE summary: Activities have included, but were not limited to, Capture the Moment (photography class), Make It Sell It (entrepreneurship), Beginning Archery & Advanced Archery.
  - Project P.A.S.S. Summary: As of November, 87 students were registered with 71 identified as active participants. Activities have included archery, art, piano, guitar, Pre-College Music, Life Skills, Recreation, and Photography.
  - MRA Summary: Activities included, but were not limited to: math, reading, science, technology, and art.
  - NSA Summary: Activities have included, but were not limited to: Math/Reading Skills focus, Kid's College, and Study Island. Student grades reflected the following:

F. Kid’s College: Each site reported student progress in mathematics and reading. Discussions were conducted regarding concerns about reading and each site determined that more time was needed in Kid’s College for reading activities.
