DATA NOTES:

All data retrieved from A-Plus system maintained by Cayen Systems on November 17th, 2011.

Site level data are compared to aggregate data for all KY 21st CCLC “Elementary School” or “Middle/High School” sites based on the proportion of student attendees in grades Pre-K through 6 and grades 7 through 12.

“Elementary School” sites are those in which at least 50% of students served were in grades Pre-K through 6.
“Middle/High” Sites are sites in which at least 50% of students served were in grades 7 through 12.

“Struggling Regular Participants” were those who earned a fall grade of “C” or below in either math or reading.

*Reading grades were available for 100% of regular participants.

Math grades were available for 100% of regular participants.

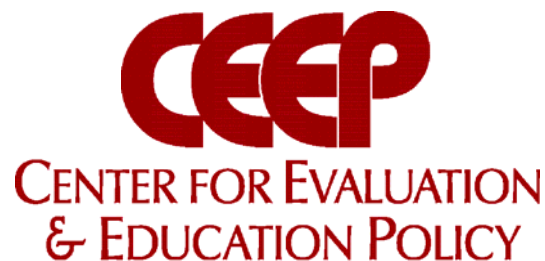
Teacher Surveys were available for 57% of regular participants.

***The percent of students who increased their grade to any extent from the fall to spring grading periods.
